

I was going to write about this some time ago, but I thought maybe it was a one-time phenomenon and didn't want to give it too much attention. Last night, however, when I heard it again, I realized it was common enough to be a problem.

I'm talking to two of my friends, a man and a woman. The man asks the woman (in a non-creepy, purely curious way) if she is bi. Her response? "No, I used to be." We both look at her suspiciously, imagining some horrific tale of love lost or the one bi-girl who was so abusive it turned her off for all time. I think we would have even given her credit for saying she went through an experimental phase and decided it wasn't for her. But when we pressed her for an answer she said, "Well, I have a boyfriend and I don't sleep with women, so I'm not bi."

Something about this answer just doesn't sit well with me. There are a couple of problems with this statement. First of all, if this

couple breaks up and she resumes sleeping with women, she will be bi again, and it just doesn't seem like something you can bounce back and forth on. You either find women attractive or you don't.

Granted, there are exceptions to every rule. I go through the occasional (very rare) times where if I have enough bad experiences with women I vow to stop dating them. It's just like when a woman gets her heart broken by a man and swears she's going to become

a lesbian or even when a woman gets her heart broken too many times in general and takes a vow of celibacy. It doesn't mean she has become sexless or frigid.

confident that things are fair.

Let's see what happens if we turn the tables. Women like to say "It's just not the same" and may truly believe that, but what if

the situations were reversed? If you were in a monogamous relationship with your boyfriend

or husband, and he was bi, would you be comfortable with him dating or fucking men? Would you say you should have the same right? If he were truly bi, would you not be afraid of his capacity to fall in love with a man? Selfishness is not living your life as you want; it's expecting others to live their lives as you want. In other words ladies, you can't have your cake and eat it too.

People go around and around on this subject. I doubt there is one final answer that will work for everyone. It's the same as with any relationship dilemma—there are as many answers as there are couples. But if we're going to analyze this from a purely logical perspective, I hate to admit it, but it is the same.



If I wanted to truly serve and protect my community, I would



I leave for the beat in ten minutes, eager to experience my first night's sleep as a real police officer.


I did it. I finally did it.





An actress who has become associated with horror films, either through an appearance in a notable genre entry, as a frequent victim or through constant appearances as the female protagonist, generally portrayed by attractive, young damsels-in-distractive.







The S1nd1cate

There are few places in the United States scarier than Idaho. After Oregon, Montana, Nevada, Utah and Wyoming agreed that not one wanted the rabbit-infested wasteland existing between them, they annexed the remaining area; turning it into a Wal-Mart farm that hosts regular Ku Klux Klan meetings. Scarier than anything Ann Rule can dig up and more relevant to this month's theme than any other Northwest-area city is Boise, Idaho, something to be feared. Naturally, any music coming from Boise *not* involving racial genocide or trailer-dwelling alcoholic anthems would be, for lack of better words, scary as hell.

Readers, meet S1nd1ca

According to the S1nd1cate's (edited) bio:

In the future, [the] stock market crash disables America's economy.
Big business merges, with a simple entity called "The Company" taking full control of the nation's resources [and] it erects its own puppet CEO as acting American president. As the working class suburbs of the country gradually dissolve into ghettos, children [are] programmed into mindless drones with two objectives maximum efficiency and maximum accuracy. The Company itself is run by a mysterious board of directors [and] rains terror and fear over the nation's citizens. Donning symbols and imagery, the underground gang founded by Mike Lee and Vert SIn adopt the title of "The SIndIcate," and continue their battle against oppression. S1nd1cate is currently recruiting new revolutionaries [through] their regular insurrection rallies. These rallies occur in the form of musical performances by S1nd1cate throughout the Northwest.

Not exactly, "Hey, we've played with The Shins so come to our next show," is it?

It would probably be appropriate to discuss the band's music, which is as innovative and explosive as the band's fictitious biography. Successfully combining goth-free industrial music with traditional punk/metal structures, S1nd1cate dishes out digestible grime like a soup kitchen server. Adding a garnish of hip-hop, BPM, and DJ-based beatmaking, S1nd1cate somehow avoids cheese and opts for beef. Like most of the artists I choose to feature in this column, S1nd1cate stands out from the competition because of their ability to channel original material from an already worn-out source. Three out of ten people living in the Northwest area are in an industrial band, and nine out of ten of these bands suck ass. Do the math.

Although limited, S1nd1cate's music does not disappoint. Truly a fine addition to any Halloween-inspired playlist is the band's surprisingly well-executed cover of "Dead Man's Party," arguably the highlight of the band's catalogue. For a duo that cites minimal production and recording assistance (seriously, these guys do everything on their own), S1nd1cate is beyond impressive. With a trail of awed fans (turned on to S1nd1cate as an opening act), a live show that features a full-stage set including horror/slasher footage broadcast via television screen and a MySpace page that loads in under four hours, S1nd1cate sits rungs above the rest of their peers on the Northwest-area band ladder, without having to resort to gimmicks or strippers.



Mike Lee (vocals, samples) and Vert (everything else) bring back the pre-Adios KMFDM-ish industrial that has been lacking in presence on store shelves since I was barely old enough to thumb through this magazine. S1nd1cate is still small enough to warrant a five dollar cover, so check them out while you can still afford to.

Nothing is scarier than sobriety. A mythical figure that exists only in the lives of people not writing for Exotic, "sobriety" is a creature that I have yet to encounter in the wild. Continuing with this month's theme of "scary shit that somehow relates to strippers," I introduce to you a band that was formed in a drug rehabilitation center and has, in their two-album career, written more songs about sex, substances and death than anything you will hear at a goth night.

Fronted and organized (in the Trent Reznor sense of the phrase) by emcee/singer Danny Boone, Rehab appeals equally to the Sublime, Rancid, Atmosphere, Hank Williams III and Ween crowds. Originally a simple DAT-backed rap duo consisting of now exmember Brooks and current vocalist Boone (Southern Discomfort, recorded over ten years ago, features this lineup and has been since re-released by Epic under a different title), Rehab has since evolved into a five-piece live act with additional rotating members. Although their debut album got the band

no farther than the occasional opening and a cancelled record contract, eight years of die-hard fans coupled with addictive single ("Sittin' at a Bar" aka "Bartender Song") helped band's

second album Graffiti the World achieve full distribution from Universal Records.

What makes Rehab's music really scary is that the band successfully performs songs in multiple genres without sounding like another hybrid band (or the last Daddy's album). Although a genuinely "Rehaby" feel (primarily Danny's unique sing-song rap vocal style) sews a consistent thread through the band's songs, it would be hard for the casual listener to notice any repetitiveness within a Rehab album and, to some extent, a single song. Typically, genre-mixing results in a catastrophic mess (Cypress Hill's Skull and Bones, Kid Rock's country-rap, Kottonmouth King's absurd self-classification as "punk"). Rehab is a breath of fresh air for the fan of punk, rap, country, folk and soul. However, this is also the band's biggest flaw, as radiolistening fans of "Sittin" at a Bar" will most likely reject pop-punk "New Tattoo" or Mickey Ayalon-esque "Let Em Know."

The Northwest connection (Rehab hails from Atlanta, Georgia) is as follows: Rockfest, a mullet-littered, trailer-parkturned-buttrock festival hosted once yearly in Portland, recently featured Kid Rock, Atraeu and Rehab. That's the equivalent of MTV Presents: Lil John, Kanye West, and Fingerbang City. A rags-to-riches act supported by fan-power alone, Rehab is not only supportive of the people who support them (the band mentions casual fans in their liner notes and regularly responds to fan mail), but as-of-yet untainted by overnight fame. Quite possibly the only band in recent years that deserves mainstream attention, check into Rehab.





Happy Halloween, my bretheren! Returning this month we have UFC, IFL and SportFight veteran and world-class Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu black belt, Fabiano "Pegaleve" Scherner performing a Standing Kimura (with optional Arm Bar) defense to a Rear Bear Hug. Also assisting us is Chad Wilker from the Scottish American Athletic Association (SAAA). The Rear Bear **Hug** is a brutish and devastating technique for lifting a body up and slamming it to the ground. The Standing Kimura is useful in defeating this attack.



Frame 1

Fabiano is in "Tequila Land" after leaving Lucky Devil on a Saturday night, when Chad sneaks up behind him and initiates a mugging.

Frame 2

Chad grabs Fabiano in a Rear Bear Hug by wrapping both of his arms underneath Fabiano's arms (at waist-to-chest level) and clasping his hands together. Fabiano's wormeating face shows he is not pleased by this disruption of his tranquility.




Frame 3

Fabiano secures Chad's left wrist with his own right hand, palm facing down, and locks Chad's left elbow by trapping it between his own left forearm and bicep muscle. Fabiano will use this position to pry Chad's left arm slightly open, so he can drive his own left arm through the opening and grab his own right wrist.



Notice the figure-four Hammer Lock Fabiano





Frame 4

Fabiano breaks Chad's grip and spins hard to his left. This motion straightens Chad's left arm and breaks his upright posture.



Frame 5

Continuing the spin, Fabiano forces Chad to the ground. Notice how Fabiano has not released the Hammer Lock and uses it to pin Chad to the mat.

Still maintaining the Hammer Lock, Fabiano drives his right knee across Chad's face and

plants it on the ground, next to his face. Simultaneously, Fabiano drops his left knee into Chad's left armpit and pinches his knees together. Chad is pretty well immobilized by these actions.

Frame 7

Hugging Chad's arm tight to his body and using the Hammer Lock, Fabiano rotates his entire torso to his left. This movement is the Kimura and it shreds the ligaments in Chad's shoulder.



Frame 8

Alternatively, if Chad is too strong for the Kimura or Fabiano elects to, he

may finish with the Arm Bar. Fabiano assumes the Arm Bar position but Chad holds his hands tight. Fabiano must break Chad's grip to finish the Arm Bar. Fabiano places his right foot on the crook of Chad's right elbow. (For the Arm Bar details, check out our column in the August 2008 issue of Exotic Magazine).




Frame 9

Fabiano presses away from his body with his right foot and pulls Chad's left arm toward his body, separating Chad's hands.

Frame 10

Fabiano finishes the Arm Bar.



The Only Theme Night That Matters

Halloween is the calendar's gift to strip clubs. On any other day of the year, panhandling candy from strangers while dressed as the gimp from *Pulp Fiction* would result in public arrest and/or humiliation. I speak from experience. The day before November, on the other hand, has historically been associated with the over-use of orange font and promises of door prizes in advertisements within this publication. Although your club is probably planning the festivities as this magazine collects ashes and Pabst-drops, the sad truth is that every other club in town is trying to upstage you. Having worked in four different clubs on Halloween, I speak (correction—urge) from experience in suggesting the following.

DJs, save the obvious for the parking lot smoke breaks and/or club catastrophes. Whether DK or Misfits, "Halloween" is a cop-out. *Rocky Horror, Nightmare Before Christmas* or other movie themes are lame and obvious as well. Most importantly, avoid Halloween-marketed singles, such as "Monster Mash" or "Nightmare on My Street." If you do decide to play something you find using the search feature on iTunes, at least make it something no one hears all month, opting for "Everyday is Halloween" (also useful for scaring 22-year-old metalheads who don't know they own every other CD by the same band).

Dancers, you go through costumes like drug-dealing boyfriends, so make sure to pick a good one for the holiday. Costume, not boyfriend.

Chances are, the "oooh, I'm eeeevil" shit has been played out and last year's costume still smells like cherry vodka, so use this

opportunity to do something that the boss wouldn't let you do on any other day. Here are some suggestions.


think. No more first dates. No more spur-ofthe-moment trips to Humboldt.

Kenny: Naw, I kill this music shit and if I didn't feel like nobody, I'm sayin' nobody, else was fuckin' with my thing I wouldn't fuck with it! When people come to see me perform we do our thing every time, like auto.

Why did you create Make Somethin Happen Records?

Kenny: My Uncle was in a group called Pleasure. They had ten albums out and they were from Portland, real big in the 70s and 80s. A lot of groups have sampled them, Jay Z sampled them. They had a bad record deal and didn't really eat like they should have eaten. When I was young, I had a deal and part of having a deal is grindin' and benefiting from the scenario. But when you run your own label, it's your dough on the line. It's kind of like being an intern. My in-house producer Crispy Hendrix does about 50 to 70 percent of the tracks at the label. The majority of the tracks on my albums are going to be from him because we have chemistry and his Uncle was the lead singer in the group Pleasure.

Nick: How do you get along with other rap artists in Portland?

Kenny: I only fuck with who fucks with me.

Nick: What are some important lessons you have learned in the rap game that the younger generation should know?

Kenny: One thing I have learned in this life, if you are a person that is going to stand up and a go-getter, you are going to eat. Life is a gamble, anyway. When taking risks, there is a positive and negative to everything you do. That's how I live.

Nick: You are known for being a strong presence in the Portland community. Are there any events lately that you have been involved in?

Kenny: My label teamed up with DJ OG

One and did a clothing drive for the high school kids in my city. It was called the First Annual Good Look Clothing Drive. I basically wanted to do it because when I was young I didn't have anything. I didn't have Nikes, I didn't have anything. That is why I had to do things to eat. It costs to eat out here.

Nick: What are some things that hold the Portland rap scene back right now?

Kenny: I feel like the city would come a long way if it came together to eat. Everybody wants the next person to come to their shows and watch them while they rock, but later they will be in the back having drinks or they rock and roll out. Just like cats from other cities coming to our city thinking the city is sweet. That's coming to an end. You can't come to the city no more if you're not showing love. If you ain't coming and dealing with the people that are running this city, that's the bottom line.

Nick: So what's on the horizon for Planet Kenny Mack?

Kenny: I got the new album and DVD The Streets Ain't Safe which is coming out in the next few months. I'm just finishing up and we're about to shoot the video for the first single. We got Pohop 10 coming up, it starts on November 22nd. We started Pohop, so that's going to be big. People can YouTube Kenny Mack or Google "Kenny Mack." Nick: Any real quick shout outs?

Kenny: Yeah, my family, M Records, Produkt of My Environment clothing line, Jus Family Records, the Fly Boy movement, the Whole 50 and Exotic Magazine.

Nick: That's what's good. I appreciate your time and thanks again.

Kenny: No problem.

I recently had the privilege to talk with a long-standing representative of the Portland music scene, the West Coast Bad Boy. Kenny Mack. You need to check the knowledge, one time!

Nick: Kenny Mack thanks for granting this interview. Let's quickly get people up to date on your latest moves.

Kenny: No problem, the record label is MSH Records (Making Somethin Happen). I co-own the label with my relative Glory. We also own Produkt of my Environment clothing line which is a custom clothing line. We specialize in custom pieces for grown-ups and kids. T-shirts, hoodies, coats, shoes and jeans. We are in the midst of our own shoe line, we also have a sub-line called 989 (life in the fast lane). We have about 400 plus pieces in circulation right now. The clothing line has been running for about eight months now, so it is still a fledgling company, but we are actually doing really well. I have been a music representative of Portland for a while now and doing music since I was a freshman in high school.

Nick: Do you ever lose that desire and hunger that has kept your game so strong for so long?


